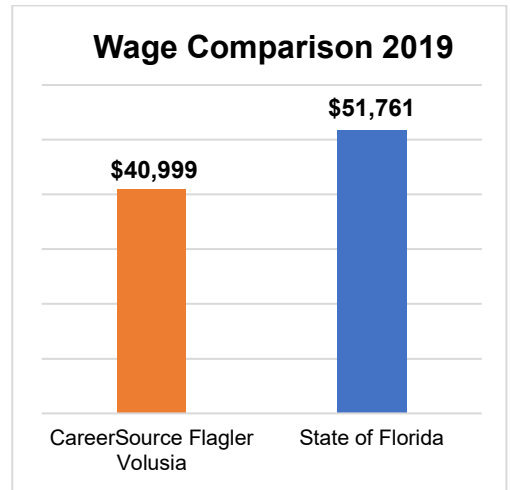
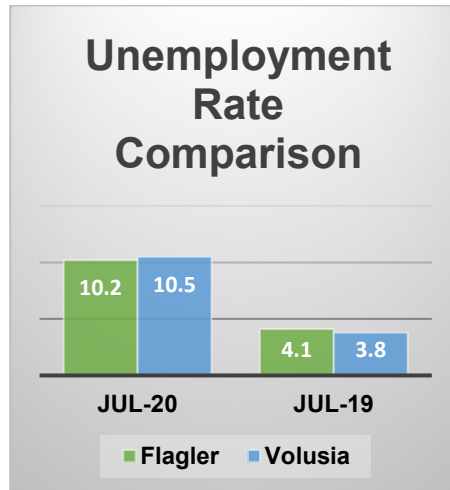
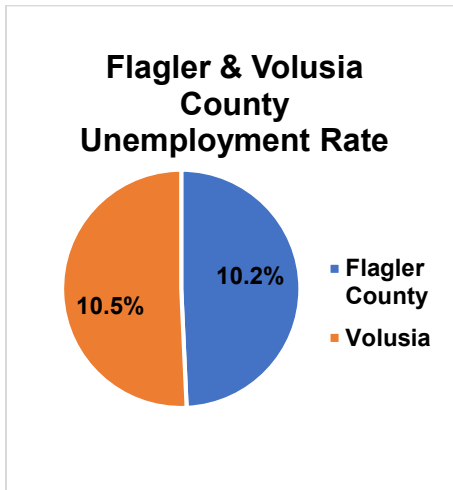
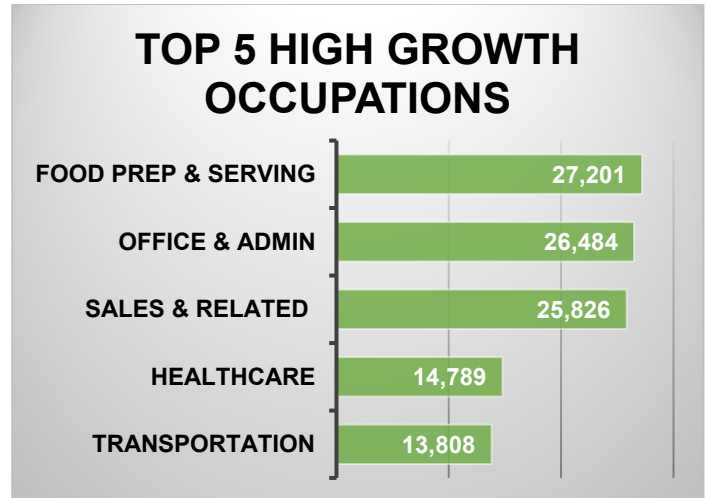
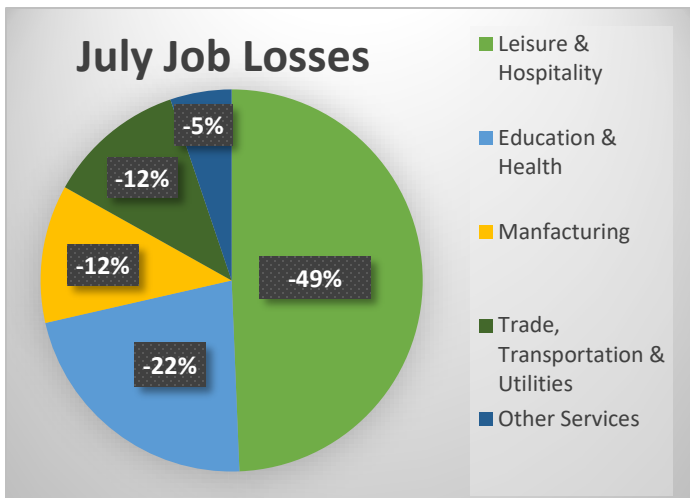


## EMPLOYMENT REPORT

The unemployment rate in the CareerSource Flagler Volusia region was 10.5% in July 2020. This rate was 6.8 percentage points higher than the region's year ago rate of 3.7 percent. The labor force was 294,054 down 9,166 (-3.0) over the year. There were 30,840 unemployed residents in the region.



In July 2020 nonagricultural employment in Deltona-Daytona Beach-Ormond Beach MSA was 195,700, a decrease of 7,100 (-3.5 percent) jobs over the year. The professional and business services (+2.1%), mining, logging, and construction (+1.4%) and government (1.3%) industries grew faster in the metro area than statewide over the year. The region was tied for second fastest annual job growth (2.1%) and tied second highest annual job growth in government (+300) compared to all the metro areas in the state. The industry gaining jobs over the year were: professional and business services (+500); government (+300) and mining, logging and construction (+200). Industries losing jobs over the year are Leisure and Hospitality (-3,800); Education and Health services (-1,700); Manufacturing (-900); Trade, Transportation and Utilities (-900); Other Services (-400); Information (-300); and Financial Activities (-100).
