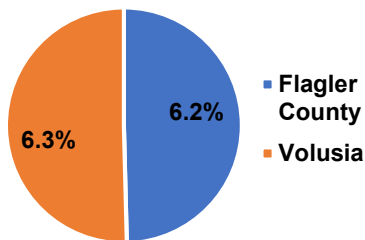


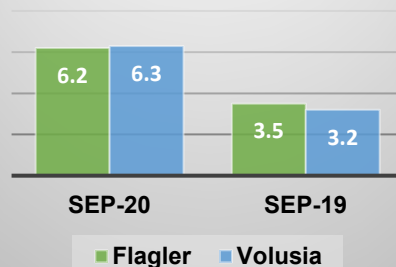
## EMPLOYMENT REPORT

The unemployment rate in the CareerSource Flagler Volusia region was 6.3% in September 2020. This rate was 3.1 percentage points higher than the region's year ago rate of 3.2 percent. The labor force was 295,414 down 8,891 (-2.9) over the year. There were 18,664 unemployed residents in the region.

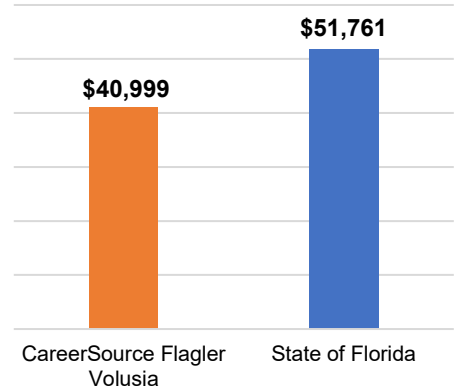
### Flagler & Volusia County Unemployment Rate



### Unemployment Rate Comparison

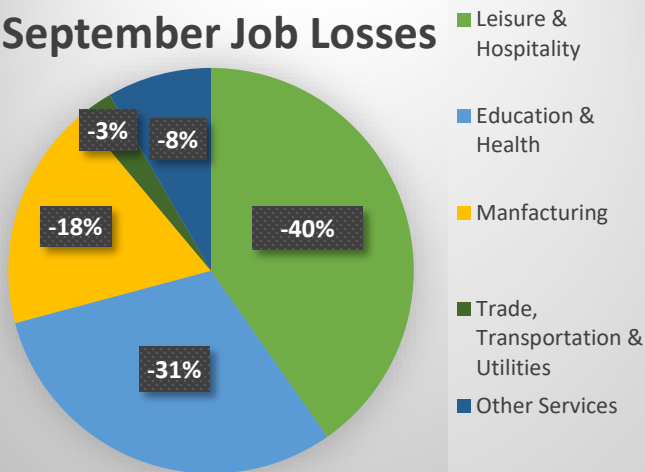


### Wage Comparison 2019

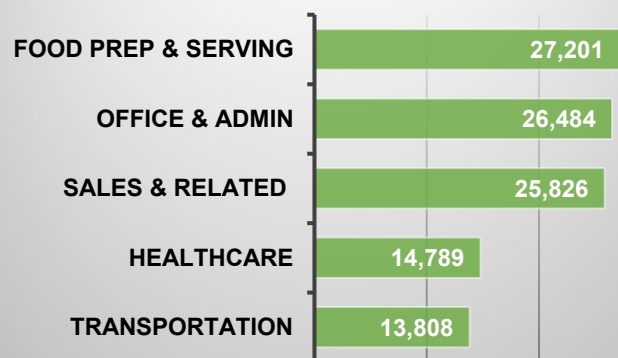


In September 2020 nonagricultural employment in Deltona-Daytona Beach-Ormond Beach MSA was 197,600, a decrease of 6,800 jobs (-3.3 percent) over the year. The mining, logging, and construction (+2.8%); and professional and business services (+1.7%) industries grew faster in the metro area than statewide over the year. The region had third fastest annual job growth compared to all metro areas in government (2.1%). The region was tied for the third highest annual job growth in professional and business services (+100 jobs) compared to all the metro areas in the state. The industry gaining jobs over the year were: mining, logging and construction (+400) professional and business services (+400); Industries losing jobs over the year are Leisure and Hospitality (-2,900); Education and Health services (-2,200); Manufacturing (-1,300); Other Services (-600); Trade, Transportation and Utilities (-200); Information (-200); and Government (-200) industries lost jobs over the year.
