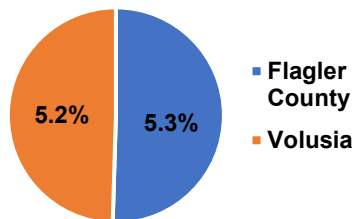


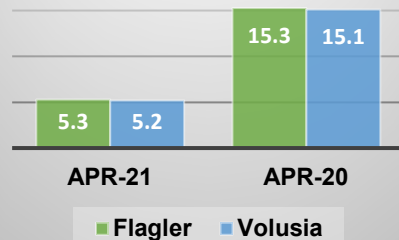
EMPLOYMENT REPORT

The unemployment rate in the CareerSource Flagler Volusia region was 5.2% in April 2021. This rate was 10.0 percentage points lower than the region's year-ago rate of 15.2%. The labor force was 303,122, up 16,757 (+5.9) over the year. There were 15,770 unemployed residents in the region.

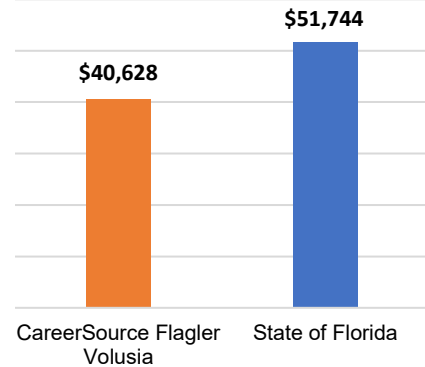
Flagler & Volusia Counties Unemployment Rate



Unemployment Rate Comparison

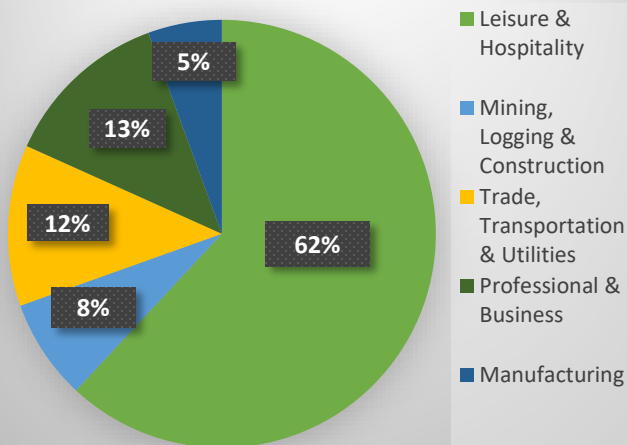


Wage Comparison 2019

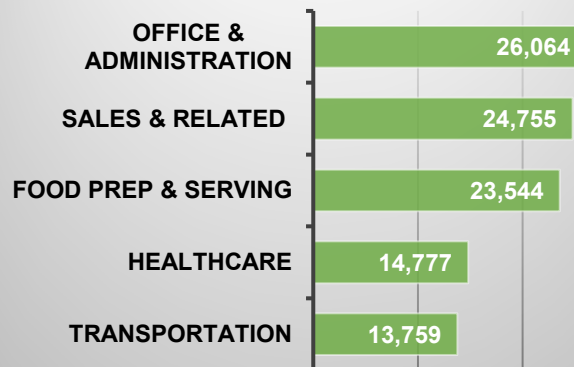


In April 2021 nonagricultural employment in Deltona-Daytona Beach-Ormond Beach MSA was 202,100, an increase of 21,300 jobs (+11.8%) over the year. The leisure and hospitality (67.4%), professional and business services (+11.4%), mining, logging, and construction (+11.1%), and manufacturing (+11.0%) industries grew faster in the metro area than statewide over the year. The region had the second fastest annual job growth compared to all the metro areas in the state in leisure and hospitality (+67.4%). The industries gaining jobs over the year were: leisure and hospitality (+12,200); professional and business services (+2,500); trade, transportation and utilities (+2,400); mining, logging, and construction (+1,500); manufacturing (+1,100); other services (+1,100); education and health services (+700) and financial services (+300) jobs.. Industries losing jobs over the year were: government (-300) and information (-200).
