

Contract

This Contract is made and entered into this 1st day of July, 2023 by and between the Workforce Development Board of Flagler and Volusia Counties, Inc., d.b.a. CareerSource Flagler Volusia, (hereafter refer to as CareerSourceFV) a Florida private not-for-profit corporation, whose principal address is 329 Bill France Boulevard, Daytona Beach, Florida 32114, and Daytona Regional Chamber of Commerce (hereafter referred to as Contractor), whose principal address is 126 East Orange Avenue, Daytona Beach, Florida 32114 , including any and all Amendments and modifications to the original Contract dated July 1, 2020.

IT IS AGREED by and between the parties as follows:

1) Background

CareerSource Florida commissioned a talent gap survey and found that there is a gap in the availability of our region's skilled workforce. Long-term solutions are needed to meet the future needs of our local businesses. The availability of a skilled workforce is widely recognized as one of the most critical factors in economic development.

The Contractor is proactively addressing the needs of our businesses through active engagement of Volusia County Schools, Team Volusia Economic Development Corporation, CareerSourceFV and other partners in retaining workforce talent in Volusia County.

2) Purpose

The purpose of this Contract is for the Contractor to create a targeted Talent Retention and Recruitment Campaign through the benchmarks listed below and outlined in Attachment :

- Student Skills Assessment: YouScience and Volusia County Schools
 - Goal: YouScience Skills Assessment provided for Volusia County Schools students in conjunction with the Career Planning guidelines developed by the Florida Department of Education.
- Soft Skills Development and Talent Retention: Youth Summit and engagement of local business community with school district
 - Goal: Address workforce development needs that have been identified across the business community regardless of industry
- Multimedia Campaign
 - Goal: Tell the success stories of students, Volusia County Schools and businesses who are benefiting from stronger connections through this initiative.
- Collaboration on business engagement programs

- o Goal: Businesses will be provided the opportunity to have input on curriculum, standards and tools through simple channels with the school district. Strong in-demand occupations will be prioritized.
- 3) CareerSourceFV Responsibilities. CareerSourceFV will assign the necessary personnel and funds to provide the following:
 - a) Review and analyze monthly reports.
 - b) Share monthly reports with key stakeholders as appropriate.
 - c) Assign one point of contact for this Contract.
 - d) Pay Contractor on payment schedule upon receipt of completed monthly status reports.
- 4) Contractor Responsibilities. The Contractor will assign the necessary resources, including personnel, to provide the following:
 - a) Complete deliverables as outlined in Attachments A.
 - b) Submit monthly reports no later than fifteen (15) days following the completed timeframe. Monthly reports will include statuses on benchmarks outlined in Attachment B.
 - c) Submit invoices no later than fifteen (15) days following the completed timeframe.
 - d) Assign one point of contact for this Contract.
- 5) Payment Schedule.

CareerSourceFV will pay \$4,166 per monthly report. The maximum amount of funding available through this Contract is Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00).
- 6) Funding

As a condition precedent, this Contract is contingent upon the State of Florida receiving Temporary Assistance for Needy Families, Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, Wagner-Peyser and Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act funds and the receipt of these funds by CareerSourceFV. CareerSourceFV is only a distributor of these funds and is not obligated further.
- 7) Confidentiality


All Parties agree to observe the confidentiality provisions of their respective programs and regulations. All appropriate information will be shared only between the Parties.

The period of the performance of the functions and services under this Contract is from July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024. Either CareerSourceFV or the Contractor may amend or cancel their involvement in this Contract as outlined in CareerSourceFV's General Terms and Conditions.


